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**MAY 1, 2023 CITY COUNCIL MEETING, AENDA ITEM #6  
PARK IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE FOR RINCONADA PARK**

The draft ordinance refers to an attached exhibit, but there is no exhibit attached, just as there was no exhibit attached for the first reading of the ordinance on January 13, 2020.

I repeat what I wrote in my April 9, 2023 email letter for the Council's April 4, 2023 meeting. (I inadvertently dated that letter as being for the August 10, 2023 meeting.)

"Maybe it would be a good idea to delay approval until the Rinconada restroom proposal is placed on a future meeting's agenda when the site plan for that restroom is included in that meeting's agenda packet at the time the packet is originally distributed and placed online."

For example, Ordinance No. 5520 for the Ramos Park restroom clearly identifies the location of the restroom for that park.

I believe the attachment required would need two exhibits: (1) all of the improvements and the part of the park where they are located, and (2) the proposed restroom and its location to scale relative to the Hopkins Avenue right of way and to both the nearest properties on the other side of Hopkins Avenue and the nearest cross streets to Hopkins Avenue.

Providing the required exhibit at places at the May 1 meeting in response to this email would not provide the public and the press adequate notice of the location of the proposed restroom.
