

PURPOSE

Review and approve the FY 2023-24 CDBG program allocations as reflected in the Annual Action Plan (AAP)



- City receives funds annually from HUD as an "entitlement" City under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.
- CDBG is the principal federal program providing localities with grants to improve the physical, economic, and social conditions in their communities.
- All CDBG activities in Palo Alto must benefit low and moderate-income persons.
- HUD requirements include:
 - Five-year Consolidated Plan Identified needs, strategies to meet needs, and sets goals
 - Subsequent Annual Action Plans Containing approved projects to be funded

- Goal No. 2: Homelessness
- Goal No. 3: Community Services and Public Improvements
- Goal No. 4: Fair Housing



Staff recommends the City Council take the following actions:

- Adopt the draft FY 2023-2024 Annual Action Plan (Attachment A) and the associated resolution (Attachment B) allocating Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for FY 2023-2024;
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to execute the FY 2023-2024 CDBG application to fund the FY 2023-2024 Annual Action Plan and any other necessary documents concerning the application, and to otherwise bind the City with respect to the applications and commitment of funds, and
- 3. Authorize staff to submit the FY 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan (Attachment A) to HUD by the May 15, 2023 deadline.
