Subject: Review of the Proposed Fiscal Year 2024 Stormwater Management Fund Budget

As directed by the City Council, the Committee met to discuss the Fiscal Year 2024 proposed Stormwater Management Fund budget on Thursday, April 6, 2023. Prior to the meeting, Public Works staff provided informational materials about the approved 2017 ballot measure and the proposed budget for the Committee's review. During the meeting, staff presented information and answered questions from the Committee members.

We have reviewed the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2024 and compared it with the provisions of the Storm Water Management Fee approved by Palo Alto property owners in 2017. We find that the attached spreadsheet describing the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2024 fairly describes the relationship between the budget and the ballot measure. Staff and the Committee concur that funding generated by the Storm Water Management Fee will be applied solely to fund the capital improvement projects, green stormwater infrastructure projects, innovative stormwater projects, enhanced maintenance of storm drain system, and storm water quality protection programs specified for implementation in the ballot measure in Fiscal Year 2024. Because funds available for green stormwater infrastructure and innovative projects are not being utilized fully, the Committee supports efforts by staff to continue to identify and promote new projects that meet the goals associated with the ballot measure, such as the proposed Green Stormwater Infrastructure capital improvement project.
