A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF PALO ALTO RECOMMENDING THE RE-
CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY ZONED
P-C AND RENDERING IN CONNECTION THEREWITH
A REPORT OF FINDINGS AND SUMMARY OF HEAR-
ING

WHEREAS, there has been filed with this Planning Commission an appli-
cation to amend Ordinance No. 1810, being the Development Plan applying to
certain property, pursuant to Articles 16 and 27 of Ordinance No. 1324, the
Zoning Ordinance, as follows:

Application No. 67-ZC-2 attached hereto
as Exhibit "1" to change the P-C District
Development Plan applying to property
known as 2905 Middlefield Road as more
fully described in Exhibit "2" attached
hereto.

AND WHEREAS, this Commission has held a public hearing on this
matter after giving notice of the time and place of hearing as required by
law and has duly and fully considered the said proposed amendment as afore-
said.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Commission of the
City of Palo Alto that the following report, findings and recommendations
are hereby submitted to the City Council of the City of Palo Alto:

Summary of Hearing:

After due and proper notice given pursuant
to Section 27.06 of said Ordinance, this
Commission held a public hearing on the
said proposed change of Development Plan
on the following date, to wit:

March 1, 1967

At the time of said hearing this Commission
considered the report of the Planning Officer
of the City of Palo Alto, which report is
attached hereto as Exhibit "3". A further
written report concerning the matters and
evidence presented at said hearing is con-
tained in the copy of the minutes of this
Commission pertaining to this matter
attached hereto as Exhibit "4" and hereby
incorporated herein.

Findings:

Based upon the foregoing referred to evidence
and hearing, this Commission has made the
following findings with reference to the said
proposed change of Development Plan, to wit:

1. That the change of said reclassification
of the subject property as hereinafter
recommended is in harmony with the
General Plan of the City of Palo Alto;
and

2. that the public interest, convenience and general welfare require the reclassification of the subject property.

Recommendations:

This Commission, pursuant to the aforerecited summary of hearing and report of findings, does hereby recommend to the City Council of the City of Palo Alto the adoption of amendment to Section 3.02 of said Ordinance reclassifying from P-C District to R-3:G District, respectively, that certain property or properties as more particularly designated, described and shown on Exhibit "2".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution and report be submitted to the City Council of the City of Palo Alto for action pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.08 of said Ordinance.
