*WHEREAS*, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year; and

*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Lydia Kou, Mayor of the City of Palo Alto on behalf of the entire City Council do hereby proclaim and call upon all citizens of Palo Alto to observe the week of April 9-15, 2023, as "National Public Safety Telecommunicator's Week" and join in honoring the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe.
