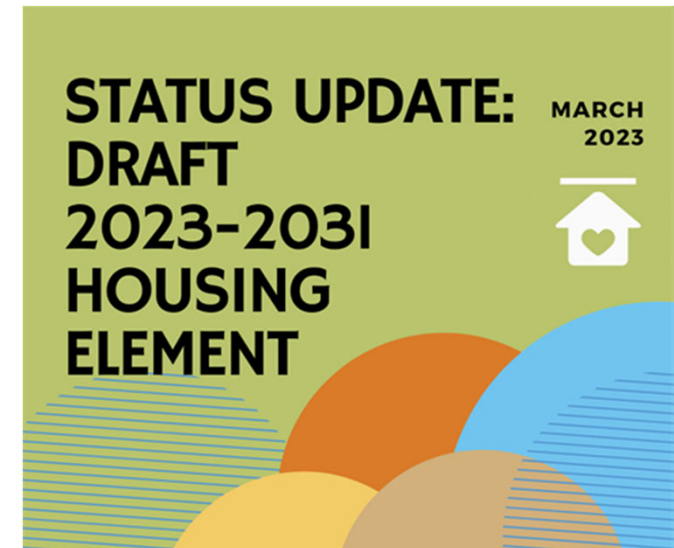

HOUSING ELEMENT STATUS UPDATE



- The Housing Element is required by state statute to demonstrate the ability to produce more than 6,000 housing element in the next eight years.
- On March 23, the City received a letter from California Housing & Community Development Department with feedback on the City's draft Housing Element.
- The revised draft Housing Element will be considered by the Planning & Transportation Commission and City Council tentatively on May 8.
